BARONIAL BUSINESS MEETING (June)

Minutes for the Barony of Red Spears JUNE Meeting at Woodland Park, Perrysburg, OH, 1-3pm on Sunday, June 12, 2022. Minutes of the previous meeting were summarized. If anyone would like to discuss something from the previous meetings, contact the seneschal.

- Old Business:
 - Discussion on pros and cons of dissolving the cantons was briefly discussed. Consensus was that it is too soon, COVID is an ongoing concern and that supporting the baronial groups and newcomers should be the focus, so the canton topic is tabled indefinitely.
 - The Charter committee is up and running but there isn't much activity yet.
- New Business and Announcements:
 - Charter Committee, Barony and Cantons are focusing on required positions. The minimum number of officers for a canton is 3 (Seneschal, Exchequer, and one based on the main activity in the group). The minimum number of officers for a barony is 7 (Seneschal, Exchequer, Chatelaine, Chronicler, Herald, Marshal, MoAS). The Chronicler is currently supporting the cantons, none of which have had a Chronicler for a long time, by distributing canton meeting news and other items of interest to the entire barony. The Webministers have been crucial in keeping the groups active online during the pandemic, posting the Spearpoint, and troubleshooting webpage, email and social media issues. Discussion is open on how all the officers can continue to rebuild and support all the areas covered by the barony.
 - Ongoing discussion: filling the deputy positions for all the offices and keeping all the required positions filled.
 - Ongoing discussion: recruiting and retention ideas

- A suggestion was made to do demos in places we haven't usually done them
 - Look into better lighting and signage at indoor meeting site entrances especially when meeting start or end after dark
 - Pennsic Preregistration ends this week!
 - Note: Aethelmearc's COVIDSafe rules are in place. Bring proof (digital is OK) of vaccination or have proof of 72-hour prior negative Covid test. Have a mask with you as you move around Pennsic for all indoors and for other areas where you may be asked to wear one. Camps are allowed to set their own camp rules.
 - Upcoming Demo: Portage 4th of July Parade. Her Excellency Bianca volunteered to make bags of candy and promotional material to toss to the crowd. The parade organizers have given the OK to toss age-appropriate items during the parade.
 - NORAD (Canton of the Marshes) is later this month, June 25. There will be a short Kingdom court, and a brief baronial court.
 - Award recommendations at the kingdom and baronial level are requested to be sent at least a month before an upcoming event in order to give the scribes ample time to complete their work.
 - Yule Feast (Canton of Hrothgeirsfjodr) has a steward, Rolf. Her Excellency Bianca volunteered to do the food as either a lunch or feast, pending discussion with the event steward. A newcomer friendly event has been requested – fun activities, intro classes on a variety of topics, and so on. Still to be decided: discussion with the meeting site on a date, other event job holders, advertising after Pennsic.
 - From the Kingdom Seneschal: start using your office midream.org email. All offices will be transitioning to that email for submitting reports.
 - Isobel needs help with the inventory of the Cateden Canton stuff.
 - Sivrid announced a marshal thing – Branos and the Detroit armored practice has visitors in from out of town the weekend of NORAD and has an open invitation to anyone who wants to drop in for the symposium Saturday or practice on Sunday.
- Officer Reports
 - The Exchequer reports no changes (see the March Minutes in this newsletter).
 - The Herald reports court will be happening at NORAD.
 - The Rapier Marshall had nothing to report.
 - The Chatelaine had nothing to report.
 - The MoAS reminds everyone making things to bring stuff to do at events in the Craftspersons Greens that are being set up at events. The next Tournament of the Arts is in September, so there is plenty of time to prepare.
 - The Chronicler the May-June newsletter is available. The July-August issue is planned to go out at the end of June or early July.
 - Webminister reports that reporting has changed to midrealm.org forms which need the officer to be logged into their official midrealm.org email in order to access. Contact access issues to the helpdesk through the kingdom webpage or email issues@midrealm.org with a subject related to the email password reset.
 - Baroness' Report:
 - Courts will happen at NORAD.
 - Court details at Pennsic will depend on how many baronial people will be there. Let the baroness know if you will be at Pennsic.
 - Use the kingdom award rec form for kingdom awards. Note – the Augmentation award of the Beacon needs to be entered into the form as OTHER, then write in

Augmentation – Beacon. This may be the last reign they are given out, but there has not been an announcement about that yet.

- The kingdom has new heirs, their graces Dag and AnneMarie
- The Marshes Seneschal reports NORAD is June 25, Thursday meetings are happening, and plans are being made for a demo at Wooster Green once students are back in town this Fall.
- The Fjodr Seneschal reports that Tuesday fighter practices are happening except for next week when the marshal will be out of town, also several baronial members have been authorized or reauthorized heavy this month. A&S nights are looking for teachers; DJ has agreed to do a calligraphy class sometime yet to be scheduled. Magrat offered to do a class on Illumination.

The next meeting will be in person 1-3 pm on July 10 in Woodland Park, Perrysburg, at or near the large pavilion. The August baronial meeting was scheduled for the day after Pennsic which most present did not think they would be able to attend so the baronial business meeting will move to zoom, tentatively scheduled for the Wednesday evening after Pennsic ends, August 17 at 7:30pm, and a **Baronial Picnic on Sunday, August 21**, in Woodland Park, Perrysburg, at or near the large pavilion, and we will grab one of the grills.

Meeting adjourned at 2:23 pm.

Old Business: Summarized notes from the June meeting

New Business and Announcements: The Charter committee will meet briefly after the business meeting today.

Officer Reports:

The Exchequer – no report

The Herald – no report

The Rapier Marshall reported that Pennsic will have a water buffalo but not the one-gallon jugs of water. Looking for large water coolers and people to help fill them. Everyone should bring their own drinking vessel to the fields, but we can also provide disposable cups. No shared drinking straws allowed.

The Chatelaine – the Wooster Green Demo is coming up this weekend July 16th. Set up starts at 1pm and we can do sparring since this isn't a rally or protest, but kids are no longer allowed to whack anyone. A social media 'event' will be posted tonight to get the news out and gauge attendance. The new deputy baronial Chatelaine is Maestra Anna Reimer von Wolfenbüttel who has agreed to step up as Chatelaine sometime next year.

The MoAS reported that there is a lot going on at events. Let an MoAS know if you are teaching anything anywhere, that's one of the items the kingdom is collecting on reports.

The Chronicler reported the July-August newsletter will be out shortly, and is requesting short items for future newsletters such as art, word searches or something fun. Still looking for a deputy. Still having trouble accessing the midrealm.org email. There is no budget for mailing the newsletter, but if anyone wants a print version, arrangements can be made.

Webminister reports that the website is up to date and working OK.

Baroness' Report:

- There are ongoing plans for retrieving various baronial items from around the barony.
- No Baronial Courts will happen at Pennsic, and it is too late to get in award recs for Pennsic, but do keep sending in baronial award recs directly to the baroness' email. Use the kingdom award rec form for kingdom awards. Note – the Augmentation award of the Beacon is still being given out this reign, but may not be for much longer. The Beacon needs to be entered into the recommendation form as OTHER, then write in Augmentation – Beacon.
- There will be a baronial ice cream social at Pennsic, probably Monday of War Week.

The Marshes Seneschal reports NORAD went well and the post-event evaluation meeting has happened on what worked and what improvements could be made. The demo at Wooster Green on BGSU campus is next weekend as the Chatelaine reported. A Search for Baron Wars sites is ongoing. Talk to Oliver if you have leads on fairgrounds or Otto if you have leads on campgrounds. The tentative date is June 2023 pending site availability. A lesson learned from NORAD is do more and better advertising for Baron Wars.

The Fjodr Seneschal reports that Rolf will be an event steward for Yule and discussions are happening on a day in December when we can use the meeting site for the event. Expect more news after Pennsic. Rolf has also agreed to take on Exchequer since the current exchequer is moving out of the barony. The three upcoming canton meetings are focusing on Pennsic Prep - a sewing machine will be available for last minute projects and the Baroness will be doing a class on How to Wear Roman.

The next business meeting will be on Zoom, Wednesday evening after Pennsic ends, August 17 at 7:30 pm. There will be a Baronial Picnic on Sunday, August 21, 1-3 pm in Woodland Park, Perrysburg, at or near the large pavilion, and we will grab one of the grills.

Meeting adjourned at 2:01 pm.

SCA 101: Populace Badges

Welcome! If you have questions, please ask! This column is written by Dorothea de Beckham and usually focuses on some of the basic jargon, experiences, and expectations of participating in the SCA (Society of Creative Anachronism). This month: What's a populace badge?

SCA group heraldic arm are depicted with a laurel wreath and used as the official presence of a group. How can the members of the group use heraldry to represent the group? Populace badges! The group's populace badge is usually the group heraldry without the laurel wreath, and may be used without special permission in any dignified way by any subject of the kingdom, or barony, or local group. It may be used as part of a heraldic standard, a specialized heraldic flag. It may be worn on a badge on garb or fighting gear. Group heraldry and badges are registered with the SCA College of Heraldry.

The badge of the Middle Kingdom is: Argent, a pale gules, overall a dragon passant vert.



The badge of Barony of Red Spears is: Or, three boar spears crossed gules



Use the following list to decipher the heraldic terms for colors:

Or	Gold, Yellow
Argent	Silver, White
Gules	Red
Vert	Green
Azure	Blue
Purpure	Purple
Sable	Black

Webminister

The Webminister helps administer the group website. Cantons maintain their own webpages and report to the baronial Webminister in the normal reporting structure, while the baronial Webminister reports to Regional and maintains the baronial webpage. The kingdom Webminister has a position more like a project manager with duties beyond the kingdom web page and help desk (<https://midrealm.org/webminister/>). The Webminister is its own office and has distinct duties from the Social Media Officer, a deputy of the Seneschal, who deals more with all types of media outlets and outward facing social media content.
